



## Sharon Geib Lankford

November 23, 1949 - January 23, 2025

Sharon Geib Lankford, of Bamberg, SC, beloved wife, mother, Oma, sister and friend, passed away at home on January 23rd, 2025.

Sharon was born on November 23rd, 1949, to Wayne and Sylvia Geib at Easton Memorial Hospital and grew up on Choptank Road, in Preston, MD. She is survived by her husband, David Lankford, of Bamberg, SC; daughter, Cherish Nielsen, and her life partner Gary Nock of Salisbury, MD; and her son, Lance Lankford, and his wife Michele Lankford of Trappe, MD. She was the oldest of six children and is survived by three - Wayne Geib, Jr., Jan Rez, and Tim Geib. She is predeceased by her brothers, Paul Geib and Mike Geib. In the summer of 1966 Sharon met David, while working as a waitress at the Dairy Queen in Easton, MD. They eloped to North Carolina and said their vows on October 19, 1967. Shortly after getting married, David joined the Air Force and the family lived in Texas, Virginia, and Germany. After returning state side, Sharon worked for Preston Trucking for many years until it closed its doors. She transitioned to the family farm business, Davon Crest Farms, as its bookkeeper and ran the tissue culture lab. Later, she managed the books for AgriMeasures, LLC - the family business in Bamberg, South Carolina where David and Sharon moved in June of 2013.

She was known as Oma to her grandchildren - Zachery Klinglesmith, Rebekah Lankford Walker and her husband William Walker, and Elise Lankford. She was also Oma for Cherish's step-children - Christie Foy, her husband Ray and 2 children Ray Keith and Madison Rochelle; and Brandon

Nielsen and his wife Faryne.

Despite discovering cancer in October 2024, Sharon was still able to attend her granddaughter Rebekah and William's wedding in Pennsylvania. As she was undergoing treatment, she was able to join her family in Florida for Thanksgiving. On January 14, she was admitted to ICU and was brought home for hospice care on January 21. She lost her battle with cancer on January 23.
