Sharon Faith Price of Centreville peacefully left the embrace of her family and loved ones to be with the Lord on Tuesday, March 8, 2011 in her home. She recently celebrated the milestone of her 50th birthday.

Born February 24, 1961 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of William Howard Coyle Jr. and Elizabeth Jane Fillhart. She grew up on Kent Island and graduated from Queen Anne's County High School, Class of 1979.
