January 10, 1987 - November 19, 2011

Sherry Nicole Voss of Kissimmee, FL died suddenly as a pedestrian in an automobile accident on November 19, 2011. She was 24.

Born in Annapolis, MD on January 10, 1987, she was the daughter of the former Deborah Ann Flannery LeFevre and Donald Frederick Voss. She attended Kent Island High School. Miss Voss worked for a property management company. In 2007, she moved to Florida to be near family.

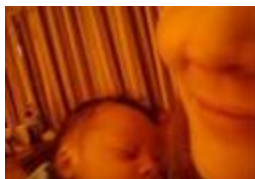
