July 14, 1934 - March 30, 2013

Shirley Eugene Theodore "Ted" Bogan of Church Hill, MD, died on Saturday, March 30, 2013, at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 78.

He was born on July 14, 1934, in Washington, DC. He was the son of the late Eugene F. Bogan and the late Gwendolyn Middleton. He graduated from University of Maryland with a Bachelor of Science Degree in 1958. In 1970, he earned a Juris Doctor Degree from American University. Mr. Bogan worked as an economist with the United States Department of Agriculture in Washington retiring in 1989. He and his wife of 56 years, Louise Leonard Bogan, resided in Bethesda until moving to Church Hill, MD, in 1999. He enjoyed many interests including reading, sailing, and woodworking.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his children, Jesse Bogan of Washington, DC, Amy Bogan of Scottsdale, AZ, Jaret Bogan of Baltimore, MD, Eugene Bogan of Ontario, Canada, Marjanna Bogan of Gaithersburg, MD; three wonderful grandchildren; a sister, Patricia O'Hanlon of Lewes, DE; many nieces and nephews; and his beloved dog, Kyle.
