Shirley May Fox, of Worton, MD, formerly of Hyattsville, MD, passed away unexpectedly, on June 10, 2024. She was 81 years old.

Born on January 10, 1943, in Riverdale, MD, she was the daughter of the late Aubrey Lee and Mary Elizabeth O'Brien Trainum. Shirley graduated from Northwestern High School, class of 1962.
