August 4, 1932 - December 25, 2010

Shirley S. Shahan Moffett of Ocean City passed away at her home on Dec. 25, 2010 and joined her Lord with her children by her side after she lost her battle with cancer. She was 78

Mrs. Moffett was born August 4th 1932 to the late Charles B. & Catherine V. Benton Stevens and grew up in Rock Hall where she raised her family. Shirley graduated from Rock Hall High School. She married Horace G. Shahan, they had three children. In 1982 she moved to Ocean City, MD and married life long Rock Hall resident Maxwell B. Moffett on the beach in Assateague. The love of the Ocean City air kept her there until her death on Christmas morning. She would return to Kent County many times over the years and stay with her dear friends Ada and Claude Joyner. She was a surrogate mother to many over the years and held a special love for her nieces and nephews. Mrs. Moffett will be well remembered for being one of the finest cooks and bakers on the Eastern Shore. She loved her family along with any others that walked through her door, cooking for all of them. Her strong faith in God and her church kept her safe until the Lord called her home.

Mrs. Moffett's career spanned several jobs including the Rock Hall Cannery, Vita Foods, Fox's Furniture Store before retiring from the Rock Hall Shirt Factory. She was a member of the Rock Hall Seventh Day Adventist Church and attended regular services in Ocean City and Salisbury, MD.
