Shirley Dorothea Mumford of Chestertown, MD died on April 17, 2003 at her home. She was 81.

Born in Newark, Maryland on August 26, 1921, she was the daughter of the late John W. and Grace Slack Mumford.

After graduating from Snow Hill High School, Class of 1938, she attended Towson State Teachers College and received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Education. She later received her Masters Degree in Education from Towson State University.

She taught elementary school in the Baltimore City School System and Baltimore County School System. She worked as a reading specialist and adult literature instructor after her retirement from Baltimore County School System and moved to Chestertown, Maryland in 1992.
