Shirley Ann Roberts of Annapolis, MD, passed away on January 20, 2019, at Hospice of the Chesapeake. She was 88.

Born on November 2, 1930, in PA, she was the daughter of the late John and Harriet Kahle Parish and grew up in Mechanicsburg, PA. She married Clarence E. Roberts in 1950, and they continued to live in Mechanicsburg adding two children to the family. Next, they moved the family of four to Pikesville, MD, and four more children were born. The last child was born after they moved to Annapolis MD, in 1963, and the seven children were raised in the house still occupied by her husband.

Shirley loved horses, animals of all types, and spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren. She was very active in her community and always was willing to volunteer to help her family and friends. Shirley loved to sing and was for a while a professional vocalist making guest appearances with such great bands as The Henry Mancini Band.
