August 18, 1942 - June 27, 2012

Shirley Ann Tate of Millington, MD, died Wednesday, June 27, 2012, at Crozure Medical Center in Upland, PA. She was 69.

Shirley Ann Tate was born August 18, 1942, in Centreville, MD, the daughter of the late William Tyler and Mary "Barnes" Tyler. Mrs. Tate was a 1960 graduate of Kennard High School.
