



Sonia Belle Speck Taylor

September 10, 1941 - May 14, 2022

Sonia Belle Speck Taylor of Church Hill, MD passed away on May 14, 2022, at Compass Regional Hospice Center in Centreville, MD. She was 80.

Born on September 10, 1941, in Martinsburg, WV, she was the daughter of the late Fred and Isabelle Dorsey Speck. Sonia graduated from Centreville High School, class of 1959, and graduated from Goldey Beacom Business School in 1960. She married Joseph G. Taylor, Jr. on July 9, 1960, and resided on Cherry Blossom Farm Lane until her death.

Sonia was a member of Price Bethany United Methodist Church for 61 years. She was director and teacher for 32 years at Tot Land Nursery School which brought her much joy. She also was a substitute teacher for Upper Queen Annes's County. In her early years she enjoyed bowling and was a swimming instructor. She looked forward to her yearly cruises with her husband Joe. She also enjoyed her time spent with her dog "Mr. Wags."
