



Sophia S. Biddle

November 4, 1918 - May 18, 2013

Sophia S. Biddle, of Easton, MD, died at the Memorial Hospital at Easton on Saturday, May 18, 2013. She was 94.

Born in Somerset County on November 4, 1918, she was the daughter of the late Alfred K. and Leila Taylor Johnson. After attending public school, she came to Talbot County in 1936 to serve as a caregiver for the Schwaninger family. She later worked at the Easton Ribbon Factory as a loom operator for 30 years.

A long time resident of Easton, she attended the Easton Church of the Brethren. Devoted to her family, she enjoyed hunting, traveling, and caring for her flower and vegetable gardening.

Her first husband, Daniel Joseph Schwaninger, whom she married on July 4, 1937, died February 26, 1965. In October of 1968, she married Harold James Biddle, who died February 27, 1984.

Mrs. Biddle, or Sophie, as she was best known, is survived by her two children, Constance S. "Connie" Greenhawk and her husband, Philemon, of Oxford, and a son, D. Joseph "Joeboy" Schwaninger, Jr., of Easton; two grandchildren, Daniel J. "Danny" Schwaninger, III, and his wife, Tina, and Samuel J. "Butch" Townsend and his wife, Lisa; four great-grandchildren,

Abby Schwaninger, Erin Schwaninger, Jack Townsend and Samantha Townsend; and a brother, Calvin Johnson of Crisfield.

She was predeceased by three sisters, Lillian Wilkinson, Esther Bell, and Agnes McGillicuddy, and two brothers, Linwood Johnson and Alfred Johnson.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, May 25, 2013, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., of Easton, where friends may call Friday evening from 6 to 8 p.m. and one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Whitemarsh Cemetery in Trappe, MD.
