



## Sophie D. Heinsohn

Sophie Dorothea Lindemann Heinsohn, of Cordova, MD, died Wednesday, September 19, 2001 at William Hill Manor in Easton, MD. She was 95

Born February 17, 1906 in Kampsheide, Germany, she was the daughter of the late Henry Fred and Anna Sophie Bruns Lindemann. She was raised in Germany and attended school there. As a young girl in Germany, she worked on the family farm. In 1923, she immigrated to America with her family, and arrived at Ellis Island. She and her family settled in Cordova, where they engaged in farming. Sophie worked on the family farm, and also at the tomato cannery in Cordova. She later returned to New York to work privately as a housekeeper and cook. In 1931, she married Harry H. Heinsohn. They later divorced. Upon retiring, she moved back to Cordova, to a home across from the family farm, a place she always enjoyed. In 1970, Mrs. Heinsohn revisited Germany, where she attended a fiftieth year reunion with her confirmation class from the Asendorf Lutheran Church. She was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Cordova for many years and also a member of the St. Paul's Ladies Aid for a number of years. She took pride in her housekeeping, gardening, and fine needlework.

Mrs. Heinsohn is survived by; her son, Harry W. Heinsohn and his wife Anne Truitt Heinsohn of Cordova; four grandsons, W. Martin Heinsohn, Lee E. Heinsohn, Jeffrey A. Heinsohn all of Cordova, Eric A. Heinsohn of Raleigh,

NC; and one granddaughter, Laura L. Ortel of Easton. She is also survived by seven great granddaughters, Elizabeth, Erin, Rachel, Amy, Mindy, and Abigail Heinsohn and Alison Ortel; also four great grandsons, Adam, Evan, Cory and Alexander Heinsohn. William H. Lindemann, her only brother, died in 1979. Also deceased are a great grandson, Dylan Heinsohn, and a great great grandson, Brendan Heinsohn.
