Stanford Leroy Bratcher of Sudlersville, Maryland died on Monday November 6, 2006 in the Chester River Medical Center, Chestertown, Maryland. He was 85 years old.

Mr. Bratcher was born near Pondtown, Maryland the son of the late William Edward and Julia Jeffers Bratcher.
