Stanley Walter Kropkowski, 92, died on July 29, 2017, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton.

Stanley was born on November 8, 1924, in Baltimore, MD. He was the son of the late Constantine (Gus) and Catherine Swinder Kropkowski.

He attended St. Casimir Catholic School. Mr. Kropkowski served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He trained pigeons to transport messages during the war in Europe. Mr. Kropkowski went on to work in the construction industry. He built a lot of banks, the dome in College Park, and the District Court House in Centreville. He retired when he was 62 as a construction superintendent for J. Roland DeShields.

He was currently a member of Wye Mills United Methodist Church and a former member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church. He was a member of the Kent Island American Legion, Post # 278.

Stanley is survived by his children, Catherine Malczewski and Linda Sue Wolfe, both of MD, and Brian James Kropkowski of SC; grandchildren, Michael and Trish Malczewski, Wendy and Scot Barnette, Adam Malczewski and Sandy Wolfe; great-grandchildren, Rylee, Mikayla, Julian, Cody, Ashley, Abigail, Luke and Mia. In addition to his wife, Margaret Turner Kropkowski, he

was preceded in death by a grandson, Keith Wolfe and eight brothers and sisters.
