Stanley Francies Schmidt, of Millington, MD the son of the late, H. Stanley Schmidt and Merle Francies Schmidt, also known as “Fritz”, in his earlier years, passed away on Wednesday, July 23, 2008 in his home. Stan was 74, and about to turn 75 on August 1st.

Stan grew up in Cockeysville, MD and graduated from Towson High School, served four years in the U.S. Army, and graduated from University of Maryland. He then married and raised his family in PA. The past 12 years he has been a resident near Crumpton, MD and has enjoyed the Eastern Shore lifestyle. Mr. Schmidt was the owner-operator of Triple S Packaging Co. and retired from his company in 2004. Stan was very involved in the community, he hauled supplies to Rock Hall and Katrina flood victims, transported toys for the Teddy Bear programs for Queen Anne’s and Kent Counties, and with Cruise for Kids organization. He was a member of several local organizations, Sudlersville Ruritan, Maryland Rough Riders, Tuckahoe Equestrian, MD League of Horseman, and local agriculture groups. He was also dedicated to his faith at Calvary- Asbury United Methodist Church in Sudlersville, MD and Crumpton United Methodist Church Crumpton, MD.

Stan loved to train and ride horses with his wife, Gail and they would take camping trips, go boating, loved his farm life, and he would talk to everyone he could along the way.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Gail and her two children, Robyn and Tyler; a sister, Suzanne Parks, and her husband, Doug and their families; and Stan's four children David, Judy, Kim and Jeff and their families.

A "Celebration of Life" service will be held at Calvary-Asbury United Methodist Church in Sudlersville, MD on Saturday, August 2, 2008 at 10 a.m. A breakfast in the church hall will follow the service.
