While no service is planned at this time, a celebration of his life will be planned for a later date, where family and friends can come together to honor the man who meant so much to so many.

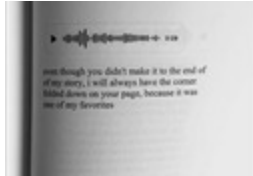
Steve will be deeply missed, but his love, laughter, and music will forever
