Stephen W. Rickard died on Thursday, April 9, 2015, at the University of MD Shore Medical Center at Easton, MD. He was 60.

Born on October 15, 1954, in San Rafael, CA, he was the son of Juliette Spencer Rickard and the late William Rickard. The family soon moved to Hilo, Hawaii.

Mr. Rickard joined the U.S. Navy and retired after 21 years of service. He married the former Linda Malyan in Hilo, HI, on February 14, 1998, and they moved to Cordova, MD, in 2000.
