March 7, 1954 - June 22, 2010

Stephen Leonard Cohey of Chestertown, MD died on June 22, 2010 while working his nets on the Chester River. He was 56.

Born in Chestertown, MD on March 7, 1954 he was the son of the late, Leonard Mason and Edith Edna Owens Cohey. He graduated Queen Anne's County High School, Class of 1972 and worked for a brief time with Maryland Department of Natural Resources and later as a self employed farmer. Mr. Cohey then went to Alaska to Salmon fish, before returning to Chestertown where he began his career as a self employed waterman. He fished nets on the Chester River for 30 years, operating the Christina C. He married Tina Campbell on September 30, 1986. Mr. Cohey enjoyed gardening, but his heart was in his work as a fisherman.

In addition to his wife, Tina, he is survived by an uncle, Mervin Cohey and his wife, Esther of Chestertown, MD and an aunt, Betty Cohey Walraven of Millington, MD. He is also survived by many cousins.
