Steven Raymond Malpede, 65, of Chester, MD, formerly of Peoria, IL, passed away on October 15, 2022. He was born on February 5, 1957, in Peoria, IL, to the late Francis and Carole Malpede.

Steve is survived by his wife, Deborah Malpede; his daughters, Carly (Daniel) Parsons of Monrovia, MD, Theresa (Raad) Yassin of Rockville, MD, and Christina (Gregory) Cannon of Carmel, IN; his grandchildren, Kylie, Alec, Matthew, Bryce, and Andrew; and his brothers, Joseph (Tina) Malpede and James (Kathy) Malpede.

He graduated from Bergan High School and went on to graduate from Bradley University in 1979. During his time at Bradley, he was a member of Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity and played short stop for the Bradley Braves. Shortly after graduating, Steve accepted a position at Hediger and Meyers as an independent insurance agent where he later became part owner and retired after 34 years.

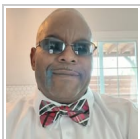

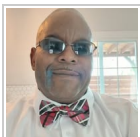
