

Steven Schilling

July 7, 1952 - March 12, 2014

Steven Leonard Schilling died on March 12, 2014, of glioblastoma at his home in Grasonville, MD. He was 61.

Born in Buffalo, NY, the son of Mr. Richard Schilling and Mrs. Virginia Gies Schilling, he grew up in Elmira, NY. Mr. Schilling graduated Notre Dame High School and entered the Air Force on April 15, 1971, where he served as a Russian linguist. After he was discharged, he moved to Maryland to pursue a career in the electrical field becoming a master electrician and most recently working for Power Solutions in Bowie, MD. He taught in the electrical apprenticeship program for 14 years and influenced countless electricians in MD.

In 1990, Mr. Schilling moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland. He truly loved life to its fullest. He enjoyed playing golf, watching movies, doing photography, and listening to music. Steve had a love for and much success with softball. He was a member of the KIUMC.

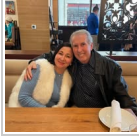
