



Stewart Lee Hoxter

June 11, 1934 - December 4, 2012

Stewart Lee Hoxter, 78, of Stevensville, MD died on December 4, 2012 after a brief illness at the Queen Anne's Emergency Center.

Born on June 11, 1934 in Chester, he was the son of the late Thomas Leonard and Ellen Elizabeth Hoxter. Stu graduated from Stevensville High School in the class of 1954 and, in 1955, married Bette Thomas, with whom he had three children. He began his career as a waterman oystering with his father, and then started clamming with his brother, William L. Hoxter. The brothers were the 7th licensed clamming operation in the state. Later, he went to work for Regal Construction Company in Washington, DC, where Stu was responsible for their small engine repair. In 1975, he married Charlotte Markham Trivett. When Regal closed in 1979, he established Island Saw and Pump Repair, which he owned and operated in Chester until 1996.

Stu was a charter member of the Grasonville Volunteer Fire Department. On October 22, 1957, he was accepted into the Knights of Pythias, where he was very active throughout his lifetime. He was known for making crab traps which were sold at local businesses, making sea glass jewelry and birdfeeders. In his spare time, Stu enjoyed taking his annual trip to Cancun, camping, fishing and boating.

In addition to his wife, Charlotte, he is survived by his children, William Keith

Hoxter of Centreville, MD and Karen Lynn Reed of Oxford, MD; and his grandchildren: Brandon Lee Hoxter, Michael Nathan Hoxter, Hunter Colby Reed, and Nicholas Jordan Hoxter. He was preceded in death by his son, Stewart Lee Hoxter, Jr.

A memorial gathering will be held from 6-8 pm on Monday, December 10 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD.
