Stig Jansson of Easton, MD died on Thursday, September 29, 2005 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 84.

Born August 23, 1921 in Sodertalje, Sweden, he was the son of the late Simon and Anna Jansson. During World War II he served in the Swedish Army. In 1952 he received his Masters Degree in Economics from the University of Stockholm. He came to this country from the Swedish State Bank to the International Monetary Fund in Washington, DC. In 1958 he went to work for Volvo, and became President of Volvo of North America. After residing in Alpine, New Jersey for 32 years, Mr. and Mrs. Jansson moved to Easton, MD in 1999, an area he had loved and visited many times.

Mr. Jansson is survived by his wife, the former June Haskell, whom he married in Oxford, England on October 4, 1956; two daughters, Karin Jansson, and Clare Jansson and her partner Nina Lipton; and a sister, Siv Wanno and her family.
