



## Stratton E. Nichols

Stratton Edgel Nichols of Easton, MD, formerly of Scituate, MA, died on Monday, August 20, 2007 at his home in Easton. He was 77.

Born November 28, 1929 in Lewistown, ME, he was the son of the late Edgel and Effie Tatamanis Nichols. After graduating from the Cheshire Academy, Cheshire, CT in 1948, he attended Boston University, Boston, MA where he earned an Associates Degree. In 1952 he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Hotel Administration from the University of New Hampshire and later a Masters Degree in Occupational Education from Northeastern University. From 1952-1954 he served in the U.S. Army, Quartermaster Corps, Fort Lee, VA.

Mr. Nichols was the owner of the Harborview Restaurant in Scituate, MA and most recently the Rehabilitation Service Training Program Coordinator for McLean Hospital, Belmont, MA.

A resident of Scituate, MA for fifty years before moving to Easton, MD in August of 2007, he was a member of the Greek Orthodox Church in Cohasset, MA and a member of the Tranquil Lodge of Master Masons in Auburn, ME.

Mr. Nichols is survived by his devoted wife of 54 years, Alcmene V. Nichols,

whom he married January 25, 1953 in Watertown, MA; two children, Dr. Thea Calkins of Baltimore, MD and Rodanthe Hanrahan and her husband Paul of Easton, MD; two sisters, Athena Aloupis of Bangor, ME and Rodanthe Nichols of Auburn, ME; and five grandchildren, Emily and Eliza Calkins, and Kaley, Christopher and Garrett Hanrahan. He was predeceased by a sister, Rita Consulas.

Private funeral services will be held on Monday, August 27, 2007 in Easton, MD.

Burial will be at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.

A memorial service will be held in Massachusetts at a later date.
