Sue Wren Horne of Easton, MD died at Talbot Hospice House, Easton on Friday, September 3, 2004. She was 70.

Born in Bryn Mawr, PA, she was the daughter of the late Harold Clifton and Mary Carroll Wren. After graduating from Haverford Township Public Schools, and the University of Delaware in 1956, she worked for the Curtis Publishing Company in PA as a Market Research Analyst. She later worked as a statistician for Virginia Polytechnic Institute in Blacksburg, VA, the Humble Oil & Refining Co. and the Jefferson Parish Library System in New Orleans while her husband completed his education. After moving to Easton, she served for a number of years as the Assistant Librarian at the Country School in Easton.

A longtime member of Christ Episcopal Church in Easton and its choir, she enjoyed traveling, golf, bowling and performing musically.

Mrs. Horne is survived by her husband, The Honorable William S. Horne, whom she married September 10, 1960; two daughters, Linda H. Prochaska and her husband, Val of Easton and Amy H. Kolligian and her husband, Kirk of Orange, CT; two brothers, James E. Wren of Stone Harbor, N.J. and William Christopher Wren of Arlington, VA, and two grandchildren, Conor and Mary Carroll Prochaska. A son, William S. Horne, II died in 1970.
