Susan Allen of Centreville, MD, died at Compass Regional Hospice on June 17, 2015. She was 69.

Born on March 14, 1946, in Orange, NJ, she was the daughter of Glydar Williams and Alice Silman Williams, who are now deceased. She graduated from East Orange High School in the Class of 1963 and went to work for the Prudential Insurance Co. briefly before becoming a childcare provider. Mrs. Allen spent over 40 years working with children, who lovingly referred to her as "Momma Sue."

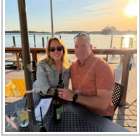
