Susan Mules Booth, 62, of Queenstown, MD passed away and into the arms of Jesus on January 17, 2026, with her husband and loved ones by her side.

She was born February 12, 1962, in Baltimore, MD to Vernon and Kathryn Mules who she loved dearly. She dedicated her life to helping others, graduating from Notre Dame of Maryland University, and pursuing a career as a nurse before switching paths to stay home and care for her children. Susan was an incredible mother to Lauren and Andrew – she was first and foremost their mom, but she was also “everyone’s mom.” She volunteered at each school that her children attended, which led to a new and very successful career in educational advancement and community engagement. She eventually became the Director of Advancement for St. Paul’s School for Girls and transitioned to Saint Ignatius Loyola Academy once her children had graduated in order to expand her impact on the community.

Susan met her husband Steve in 2005, and their love blossomed quickly and they were married on May 12, 2007. Where you found one, you would always find the other and they knew nothing but true and unfailing love in their 21 years together. He was the absolute love of her life. They retired together, moving to the Wye River to fulfill her lifelong dream, and spent much of their time together boating, traveling, attending Ravens games, gardening, doing puzzles and entertaining others with her fabulous cooking.

Susan became “Grammy” in 2012 and delighted in her four grandchildren. She and Steve frequently traveled to spend time with them, enjoying every second they could be together.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Vernon and Kathryn (Kathy) Mules and is survived by many loved ones including her dedicated husband Stephen Booth, her daughter Lauren Gilberti, her son Andrew Gilberti (Emily), her four grandchildren: Kathryn, Blaine, Cannon, and Jackson, and her sister, Leigh Thomas.
