Susan Drummer Gannon, 78, of Easton, Maryland, passed away peacefully on April 4, 2026.

Born on May 5, 1947, in Grasonville, Maryland, Susan was raised in the community she always held close to her heart. She dedicated over 30 years of her life to caring for children as the owner of a home daycare, where she became a trusted and beloved presence for countless families.
