“ I first met Susie Lynn McKoy around 1986-87 when she came to visit her father, Tom McKoy, and I opened the door. It was an awkward 60 seconds for both of us. Susie would introduce me as her step-mother rather than her dad’s wife; each time I felt accepted and honored when she did because it was genuinely from her heart.

For nearly 28 years I had the opportunity to know and love Susie. She was a bright light, she lived for the joy of life, she had an infectious laugh, and almost always had a smile on her face. She had the type of smile that made her entire face light up. Susie was no saint, and like all of us, she was flawed. She had her demons, her lifelong battles, but two things could not be argued by anyone who knew her. She adored her dad, and she was fiercely devoted to her sons.

Susie’s biggest joy, her greatest accomplishments in life were her sons. She was devoted to them and would defend or protect them from all comers. They weren’t just her heart; they were her life. To Ricky and Mils, I say no one could or will ever love you more than your mother did. Make her proud as you go thru life and keep her memory close to your hearts.

One of my best memories of Susie was when she lived with us for a while. She took a job at Rips Restaurant and nearly every night she’d come home with a bag of fresh muffins. No matter what else came home with her, she always had muffins. They definitely were good muffins. When she finally found housing on Eastern Shore, she would visit us and I asked her one day if she missed working at Rips. She said she kept in touch with some of the staff, and the money had been nice, but what she missed most were the muffins. That was Susie, something as simple as a muffin made her happy.

I will miss her, her smile and her laugh. For anyone who believes in

Heaven, I chose to believe that when Susie left this life, her soul was greeted by her father, Tom, with his arms open wide to welcome her home. And on the day of her funeral, it is almost poetic, and definitely ironic, that we say goodbye to her on the exact date of her father's passing, January 22, 2013. They will both be watching over us as we say our goodbyes, and as we live with their memories always in our hearts.
