Suzanne Marlowe Chute passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 18. She will be remembered as a beautiful mom, daughter, wife, sister, and friend with a huge heart and a fierce love of life. Born in Hingham, MA, Suzanne graduated from Endicott College with a degree in marketing before setting out on her many bold life successes. Her early careers included as a model, TV weather anchor, and real estate broker. Drawing on her deep talent for creative design, she returned to school to obtain a degree in Interior Design from New York School of Interior Design in the late 1980s. With an innate sense of design potential, Suzanne had a vision for how any room or building could be transformed. In partnership with her late husband, Jack, she renovated and remodeled multiple buildings first in Connecticut and then in St. Michaels, Maryland.

In the heart department, there was no match. From dragging her family to soup kitchens, chasing down beds for families in need, working with medically fragile children, delivering carloads of poinsettias to neighbors and friends at Christmas time, to pulling off epic St. Michaels July 4th celebrations, Suzanne's drive to help others was boundless. To say she will be missed doesn't capture the impact that she had on those around her, but just the same and quite simply, she will be deeply missed. A memorial service will be held later this summer. In lieu of flowers and in honor of her deep love for
