Suzanne Egli, spouse of the late Adolf Egli of 50 years, of Oxford, died on Sunday, March 20, 2005 at her home, surrounded by her loving family. She was 98.

Born in La Chaux-de-Fonds in the Canton of Neuchatel in Switzerland on June 24, 1906, she was the daughter of the late Julien Oppliger and Mariette Meylen Oppliger. She graduated from the Ecole Superieure de Commerce and was employed as a multi-linguist translator in Zurich and Philadelphia.

Suzanne was an active volunteer. She began her 50 years with the International Red Cross during WW II. She also read for the blind, taught French and Yoga and was a docent with the Detroit Institute of Arts. She supported the symphony, local artists, musicians and poets. Accomplishments included being a multi-linguist, jewelry maker, gardener, fitness & health food mentor and world traveler. Suzanne completed the Sivananda Teacher's Training in 1986 and taught Yoga for many years.

Surviving are two daughters, Suzanne A. Maughan and Raymonde Egli-Bielak; grandchildren, Kevin Maughan, Angeline Maughan, Maia Bielak, Arielle Bielak and Britta Bielak; and great-grandchild, Amelia Marie Maughan.
