



Suzanne Harrison Grimes

October 11, 1938 - November 22, 2023

Suzanne Harrison Grimes, of Oxford, MD, died unexpectedly on November 22, 2023, at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore. She was 85.

Born October 11, 1938, in Mather, PA, she was the daughter of the late Charles and Jane Densmore Harrison. Suzanne received her master's in teaching from Bowie State College and taught early education throughout Prince George's County and Anne Arundel County.

Suzanne was a life member of the Oxford Fire Department Auxiliary, a member of the Red Hat Society, a devoted volunteer at the Oxford Library, and member of the Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford. She loved music, especially playing piano, gardening, traveling and reading.

Along with her parents, Mrs. Grimes is predeceased by her husband, the late David W. Grimes, and a brother Ronald D. Harrison.

She is survived by her children; Douglas Grimes (June) of Sykesville, MD, Denise Johansen (Jay McCLung) of New Kent, VA, Dr. Jonathan W. Grimes of Rosedale, MD and Jane Grimes (Thomas Robey, Jr.) of Dunkirk, MD. She is also survived by her seven grandchildren: Jamie, Joshua, Kate, David, Anna, Karen, and Randy; along with three great-grandchildren and her sister, Judith Harrison of Raleigh, NC.

A memorial service will be held at the Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford, MD on Saturday, December 9th at 11am. Inurnment will follow at the church columbarium.

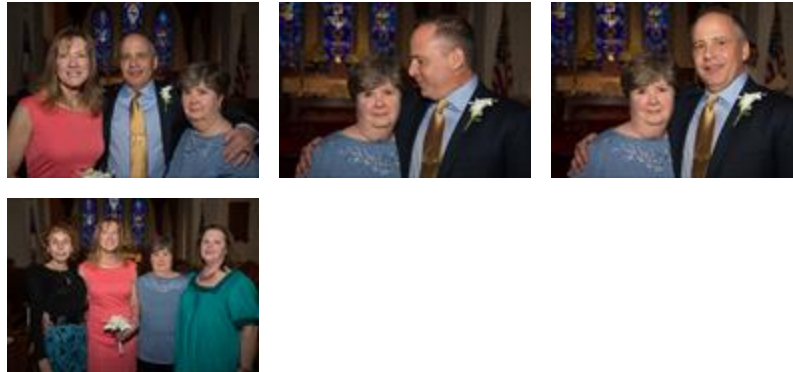
