November 5, 1965 - February 7, 2015

Suzanne Jane Swensen of Parkton, MD, succumbed to a seven and a half year battle against cancer on Saturday, February 7, 2015, at Stella Maris Nursing Home in Timonium, MD. She was 49.

Born November 5, 1965, in Morristown, NJ, she was the daughter of Linda Jane Saulsbury of Centreville, MD and the late Milton Foster Saulsbury. The majority of her younger years were spent in Centreville, MD. She always looked forward to going to her childhood home and enjoying the serenity of Grove Creek. She graduated from Queen Anne's County High School in 1983 and Towson State University in 1987 with a Bachelor's in Political Science.

Her greatest joy in life was nurturing her four children. Suzie had an eleven year career with the Department of Defense, but with the arrival of her third child, she became a stay-at-home Mom.

She took such pride in Eric's photography, Kelli's artwork and athleticism; Emma's skills being a lacrosse goalie; and Jason's love and creativity with Legos. What she looked forward to most was watching her kids play sports and laughing at funny shows with them. It was her great escape during the years of her fight against cancer. She was dedicated to physical fitness and the joy of running. She also enjoyed reading and always had a book in hand. She was an avid fan of the Avett Brothers' music.

Suzanne is survived by the father of her children, Christopher Swensen of Freeland, MD; her precious children, Eric, Kelli, Emily and Jason Swensen all of Parkton, MD; mother, Jane Saulsbury of Centreville, MD; brother, Steve Saulsbury and his wife, Cathy of Centreville, MD; sister, Laura Covey of Easton, MD; devoted aunt, Susan Pillsbury of Catonsville, MD; one niece; and four nephews.

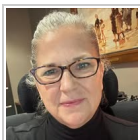
