Sylvia Bigelow Houghton Garrett of Easton died October 29th at Talbot Hospice. She was 91.

Born July 3, 1933 in Corning, New York, she was the daughter of Jane Olmstead and Arthur Amory Houghton, Jr. She went to grade school at Nightingale-Bamford in New York City, attended prep school at Foxcroft in Middleburg, Virginia, and then returned to Manhattan to study at Parsons School of Design.

During her years in New York, she was an active member of the Colonial Dames of America and the Colony Club. After moving to Easton in 1978, she became an avid supporter and volunteer at the Waterfowl Festival, and served as president of the Talbot County Historical Society. She also had a deep love for Maine, and was a lifelong summer resident of Northeast Harbor on Mount Desert Island.

She is survived by her sons David and Stephen, daughters-in-law Tracy and Rachel, and granddaughter Amelia.

She was predeceased by her husband of 43 years Richard, and her eldest son Michael.
