



Sylvia Mende Griffith

November 26, 1920 - May 11, 2013

Sylvia Mende Griffith died on May 11, 2013, at Talbot Hospice House. She was 92.

She was born on November 26, 1920, in Cambridge, MD, to the late Gustaf and Laura Cox Mende.

Mrs. Griffith worked at the Maryland State Health Dept. Bureau of Laboratories in Cambridge and Easton for many years. After retiring from the State of Maryland, she worked for various doctors in Easton and Cambridge.

In 1940, Sylvia Griffith married Franklin W. Marshall of Easton. Their daughter Frances Dee Newnam died on September 21, 1990.

In 1960, she married H. Matthew Griffith who died January 9, 1989.

She was a member of Trappe United Methodist Church, past President of Trappe Homemaker's Club, and was a dedicated helper at the local polling stations. Sylvia was also the very first Miss Outdoors, Cambridge, MD.

She was very interested in painting and had a number of showings. Flowers and gardening were a lifelong hobby and she enjoyed writing poetry.

Mrs. Griffith is survived by one sister, Joyce M. Tschantre and her husband

Leon of Milford, DE, one grandson, Michael Eric Williamson of Easton, and many nephews and nieces.

She was preceded in death by her husband, H. Matthew Griffith; her daughter, Frances Dee Newnam; brothers, Gus M. Mende and Gordon R. Mende; and three sisters, Selina Ann Kurlak, Betty Mende Abele, and Carolyn Becker.
