Sylvia Ann Trayser of Centreville Maryland passed away on Tuesday, May 7, 2024.

She was born in Baltimore on June 13, 1951, to Ethel Naomi Joiner and Phillip Gerard Trayser.

She grew up in the Highlandtown community of East Baltimore, where she established lifelong friendships at St. Matthews Church. Sylvia loved the Eastern Shore of Maryland and cherished her childhood summers spent there with her Aunt Agnes Stauffer, her grandmother Annie Estelle Joiner, and her many cousins. Her father Phillip Gerard Trayser was an artist and from him, she inherited a natural sense of creativity and artistic ability. She loved to sew, crochet, and make crafts.

Later in life, she used her talents to paint rocks for kindness, which she met weekly with a group of friends she called 'The Rockers' Sylvia's other hobbies included reading, and traveling to Tennessee and Ireland.

She is remembered for her warm-spirited nature, her positive outlook on life, her sense of humor, and her ability to make friends wherever she went.
