



## Sylvia L. Morris

December 3, 1934 - March 23, 2011

Sylvia Lewin Morris of Easton, formerly of Bowie, died on March 23, 2011. She was 76.

Born in Augusta, Maine on December 3, 1934, she was the daughter of the late, Brigadier General Theodore Lewin, USANG and the late, Florida Cook Lewin. She graduated from Falls Church High School in 1953 and Gorham State Teacher's College in 1957. She then attended the University of Maryland, taking several graduate courses. She began working as an elementary school teacher in Auburn, Maine from 1958-1959, and then taught at the Port Layote Naval Base in Morocco. In 1965, she continued her career in education working for the Prince George's County Public School System, retiring from her position at Tulip Grove Elementary in 1995.

Mrs. Morris loved her pets and sports. She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Girl Scouts, and was involved in the Augusta Playgrounds.

She is survived by her children, Mark Morris and his fiancée, Jill Carpenter of Easton, and Peter Morris and his wife, Lori of Easton; her brother, Rear Admiral Theodore Lewin, USN, Retired and his wife, Jan of Alexandria, VA; her sister, Cynthia Hennessey and her husband, Richard, of Jefferson, ME; her granddaughter, Hannah Morris of Easton; and her nephew, Daniel

Hennessey and his wife, Denise of Warren, ME.
