Sylvia Lavada Hackett of Queenstown, MD died Sunday, March 13, 2005 at her residence. She was 66.

Born on March 22, 1938 in Secretary, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Hazel Virginia Sard and Alfred Mohsay Hackett. She graduated from the Samuel Ready School for Girls in 1955 and in 1959, she graduated from Wake Forest University with a Bachelor of Arts degree. She began her career and worked for over forty years for the Department of Social Services in Baltimore County. During that time, she received a law degree from the University of Baltimore Law School. She was a member of the Bar Association of Maryland and the Bar Association of the District of Columbia. While residing in Catonsville and working for social services, she held a private practice until relocating in 1994 to Queenstown, MD and retiring in 1997.

She was a member of the Presidents Club of Wake Forest University, 1988-1998. She served for many years on the board of trustees of Samuel Ready Scholarship Fund, Inc. She was a member of the Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Arbutus, MD where she was active in the choir and played the piano and organ. She was a member of the Old Wye Parish Church in Wye Mills, MD, where she served on the cemetery committee. Sylvia was known as the "Institutional Memory" for all of her friends.

Miss Hackett is survived by a cousin, Elizabeth McMahon of Easton, MD and many close friends, Robert Glaeser of Chester, MD, Becky Powel of Union Bridge, MD, Mary Jean Spencer of Murrysville, PA, Helene Riser of Island Heights, NJ and Betty Johnson of Baltimore, MD.

Services will be held on Thursday, March 17, 2005 at 2pm at the Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, 315 Goldsborough Street, Easton, MD. Friends will be received one hour prior to services. Interment will follow in East New Market Cemetery.
