



## Taylor Lednum Sr.

February 12, 1943 - February 27, 2017

Taylor J. “Jerry” Lednum passed away on February 27, 2017, surrounded by his loving family. He was 74.

Born in Baltimore and raised on Tilghman Island, Jerry was the son of the late James Taylor Lednum and Dorothy Elizabeth Lednum.
