Ted William Bates of Easton died on Thursday, November 19, 2009 at the Genesis Healthcare the Pines. He was 75.

Born on March 1, 1934 in Alliance, Ohio, he was the son of the late, James E. and Nettie Martin Bates. As a youth, Ted was an integral part of his community and helped establish Beechwood Park. After high school, Ted enlisted in the Marine Corps where he was a Drill Instructor and a football team member in Paris Island, NC. He then attended and graduated from Catawba College in NC where he also played football. Ted later took a position as a chemical engineer with Ashland Chemical Company. Following his retirement from Ashland Chemical Company he moved to Easton and formed the company Alpha Property Services, INC; a residential and a commercial appraising service. During his working career, Ted made many lifelong friends.

In his spare time he enjoyed many sports and was an avid golfer throughout his life. Ted also enjoyed boating and tennis.

Ted is survived by his wife, Marilyn and her two sons, David and Jonathon; two grandchildren and his sister, Virginia Morrow. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his first wife, Jane with whom he had three children, Pam, Karyn, and Brad, and three grandchildren; his second wife, Barbara in
