June 15, 1931 - December 20, 2016

Terence G. Dell died December 20, 2016, in Easton, MD. He was born on June 15, 1931, in Page, ND. He was the son of the late Beryl William Dell and Florence Marguerite Kennedy Dell.

After graduating from Breckenridge High School in Breckenridge, MN, he served in the United States Air Force, and then graduated with an electrical engineering degree from North Dakota State University. He was employed by the Westinghouse Electric Corporation in Annapolis, MD, for 29 years.

After raising his family in Arnold, MD, he moved to Easton in 2002, where he served on the board of the Easton Club Community Association and on the Easton Town Planning and Zoning Commission. He was also on the board of the Institute for Adult Learning at Chesapeake College, where his lifelong love of music led him to teach classes in jazz, blues, and folk music.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Phyllis Dell; his children, Sheila Burnett, Wendy Dell, Philip Dell (Amy), Brendan Dell; and seven grandchildren. He was predeceased by his son, Michael Dell.
