



## Terrence "Terry" Armstrong

April 25, 1963 - September 21, 2013

Terence William "Terry" Armstrong of Chestertown, MD, died from injuries sustained in a highway accident on September 21, 2013. He was 50.

He was born in Baltimore, MD, on April 25, 1963, the son of Virginia Stein and Samuel Armstrong. He was a 1981 graduate of Polytechnic High School in Baltimore and attended William and Mary College.

In 1999, he married Lorraine "Lori" Hurlbutt. They moved to Chestertown in 2002 where Terry worked as a marine mechanic with Haven Harbor until more recently when he worked with the Port of Annapolis Marina. His entire life revolved around his 12-year-old son, Brooks. Terry also enjoyed all things outdoors.

In addition to his parents and his former spouse, he is survived by his son, Brooks Armstrong of Chestertown, MD; two sisters, Gretchen Hathaway of Bel Air, MD, and Susan Morgan of WV; a brother, Christopher Armstrong; along with many nieces and nephews, and friends.

Services will be held on Friday, September 27, 2013, at 4 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD 21620.
