



## Terrence "Terry" John Wolf

January 22, 1946 - October 1, 2017

"Terry" Wolf (Terrence John), of Sudlersville, MD, passed away on Sunday, October 1, 2017, at his home. He was 71.

Born on January 22, 1946, in Wilmington, DE, he was the oldest son of the late John Howard and Hilda O'Brien Wolf. He was a graduate of William Penn High School, Class of 1964. Terry was a carpenter, a construction superintendent and most recently retired from his own company, Eastern Shore Irrigation. Terry was a member of the Upper Eastern Shore Anglers Association. While Terry was an avid hunter and fisherman, his true passion was painting. Terry was a painter his whole life and studied at the Barnes Foundation, Merion, PA. He exhibited his art from Maine to Florida during his life. His most joyful experience was demonstrating egg tempera painting at the Brandywine River Museum.
