Thelma Rose Jackson of Easton, MD, died on December 17, 2018, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton.

She was born in Wittman, MD, on March 24, 1927, one of eight children of the late Millard J. J. and Mary Dorothy Marshall Fairbank. After attending public school, she worked at the Chesapeake Shellfish Company in Sherwood and then as a floral designer at Murdoch's Florist in Easton from 1973 to 1989. During the 1990's, she worked as an antiques dealer. She had resided in Easton since moving here from Wittman in 1972.
