Thelma B. Muhly Green passed away July 10th at Corsica Hills Center at age 86 peacefully in her sleep. Born in Baltimore she was the daughter of the late William and Thelma Meseke. She was raised in Baltimore, graduated from Eastern High School, and married her high school sweetheart, Edwin Muhly Jr., with whom she had three children. She is survived by oldest son E. Christian Muhly III, (Missy) of Millersville, daughter Dale M. Hall, (Lenwood) of Stevensville and youngest son, Charles W. Muhly of Ensenada, Mexico as well as three grandchildren, Taylor Muhly, Adam Hall and Kiersten Muhly. Thelma was formerly of Linstead on the Severn in Severna Park where she raised her children. Subsequently she was employed at the Saltbox dress shop in Annapolis. She retired to Fort Meyers, FL, then following her husband's death returned to Maryland's Eastern Shore to be closer to her children.

Thelma's love of painting began in her preteens. She painted prolifically with water colors, acrylics, and oils, and spent the last years of her active life participating in art groups such as Kent Island Federation of Arts, The Creative Edge, and Art East, painting, teaching, and exhibiting in art shows. She shared her love of art with daughter, Dale, with whom she participated in many shows, the last including a mother/daughter show at Woods Church in Severna Park.
