Thelma G. Leahy, of Easton, MD, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Thursday, December 19, 2002. She was 92.

Born in Westwood, N.J., March 11, 1910, she was the daughter of the late Cecil Anderson and Edith Bush Gardner. After graduating from Westwood High School, she attended Montclair State College in Montclair, NJ where she earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in English. She then worked as a secretary for the Director of Public Relations for the Boy Scouts of America in New York. Following her marriage on June 3, 1939 in Westwood, NJ to Guilbert J. Leahy, they moved to the Maryland Area. She attended the University of Maryland where she received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education. She then taught for twenty-three years in MD, VA and NJ before retiring in the late 1970's.

A resident of Easton since 1981, she was a member of the National Education Association, the Maryland State Teachers Association and the New Jersey Education Association. After moving to Easton, she tutored for several years in the Talbot County Project Read Program.

Her husband died March 23, 1969.

Mrs. Leahy is survived by a daughter, Barbara L. Prettyman and her husband,

Richard of Easton; a son, Colonel Robert G. Leahy, USAF/ret. and his wife Elaine of Easton; four grandchildren, Lynn Ruth McDorman, Catherine Anne Outten, Steven Leahy Prettyman and Robin Anne Shewmake and six great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at the graveside at Westwood Cemetery, Westwood, NJ on Monday, December 23rd, at 1 P.M.
