Theodore Paul Kral, 90, of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully on February 13, 2025. Born in Chicago, IL, to Marie Keil Kral and Dr. Theodore Thomas Kral, D.D.S., Ted was a proud graduate of Loyola Academy and in 1957 earned his Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from his beloved Northwestern University.

Ted began his professional journey in Chicago, where he worked for Central Envelope and Lithography Company for seven years. In 1965, he relocated to Allentown, PA, to join Boise Cascade Envelope. Tidewater. Ted had a fondness for coffee, Moose Tracks ice cream, and a nice buttery chardonnay.

Ted was preceded in death by his wife, Ellinore Booth Bargamin, his mother, father, and sister, Marie "Penny" Kral Kobeski (Ron).
