Theodore R. Baker died at the Memorial Hospital on November 23, 1999 of complications of cancer and heart. He was 61 years old.

Born in Queenstown MD on July 14, 1938 the son of Lorraine Haberman. He attended Queen Anne's County Schools. In 1956 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in the Korean conflict in Korea. On April 15, 1959 he married Hila Thompson of Grasonville MD. After his discharge from the Army he served as a correctional officer for the State of Maryland Correctional System, and retired in 1977. Mr. Baker will be remember for may jobs including, income tax preparation, the owner and operator of H&R Country Store in Millington, Managing the VFW in Grasonville. He served for 20 years as a hearing judge on the Property Assessment Board in Queen Anne Anne's County for the State of Maryland.

He was a member of Grasonville VFW Post # 7464, Queenstown American Legion Post and The Bay Country Moose in Queenstown, MD.

He is survived by his wife: Hila Thompson Baker, his mother, Lorraine Haberman of Queenstown MD, Two sons: William R. Baker of Centreville MD, Robert B Baker of Grasonville MD, one daughter : Ruth Ann Kayhoe of Queenstown MD. Two Brothers: Hal Boulden of Stewardstown PA, and Clinton Baker of Easton MD.
