Thomas Beskid of Centreville, MD died at his home on Thursday, May 8, 2003. He was 78.

Born on February 9, 1925 in Pittsburgh, PA, he was the son of the late John Beskid and Mary Fechko Beskid. He attended Pittsburgh High School and graduated class of 1943. After high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving in the South Pacific. In 1946 he was honorably discharged, and after returning home he began working at the Veterans Hospital in Butler, PA. On April 17, 1947 he married Mary Ruth Barcus of Centreville, MD and they resided together in Butler, PA for a short period until moving to Centreville. While residing in Centreville, he and his wife owned and operated Beskid Grocery Store. In the mid 1970's, they closed the store and he began working for the Queen Anne's County Sheriffs Department as a deputy. He later worked as a security officer for the Chesapeake College until 1990.

Mr. Beskid was a member of the American Legion Jeff Davis Post #18 and VFW Post #7464. He enjoyed fishing, reading, crabbing, cowboy movies, crossword puzzles, his great grandchildren and grandchildren, and his family.

In addition to his wife Mary Ruth (Barcus) Beskid, he is survived by one son, John C. Beskid and his wife, Judi of Centreville, MD; three daughters, Jacqueline M. Murray and her husband, Thomas of Baltimore, MD, Sarah E.

Frantz and her husband, James of Centreville, MD, and Kathleen A. Judy and her husband, Conrad of Arnold, MD; two sisters, Helen Shulin of Cleveland, OH; Betty Aron of Cleveland, OH; one brother, John Beskid of Houston, TX; seven grandchildren, Andrew C.
