



Thomas Robert Garvey Jr.

Thomas Robert Garvey, Jr., 64, of Oxford, MD, died on Thursday, August 22, 2013, at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD. He was born in Queens, NY, on February 14, 1949, son of the late Thomas Robert Garvey, Sr., and Mary Leola Carruthers Garvey.

Tom served in the United States Navy aboard the USS Saratoga from 1967 to 1971. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal as well as the Meritorious Unit Commendation Medal. He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton, Boilermakers Union Local # 30, and was a contributor to the Wounded Warriors Project.

He is survived by his wife, Virginia A. Garvey of Oxford; two brothers, Douglas Garvey and Jeff Garvey, both of Virginia Beach, VA; a sister, Gwynne Duarte of Kauai, HI. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Bruce Garvey, and a sister, Roberta Johnson.

A visitation will be held on Sunday, August 25, 2013, from 2 to 4 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 South Harrison St., Easton, MD 21601.
