Thomas Davis Glenn of Rock Hall, MD, died on Thursday, July 17, 2015, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown. He was 68.

Born on June 4, 1947, in Chestertown, MD, he was the son of the late Eldridge Millard Glenn, Sr. and Delma May Davis. A graduate of Rock Hall High School, Mr. Glenn served in the United States Navy in 1965. He returned to Rock Hall where he worked as a self-employed waterman before joining the carnival where he traveled extensively up and down the East Coast, a job he truly loved and developed his fondest memories.

He is survived by a daughter, Donna Dehn of OH; his companion, Anna Thomas of Rock Hall; and her children, John Christopher Thomas, and the late Anthony Thomas; along with numerous cousins in Rock Hall.

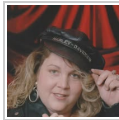
A graveside service will be held in Wesley Chapel Cemetery privately at a later date.
